AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school safety programs in school districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 160.671, to read as follows:

160.671. 1. As used in this section, "school safety program" means any public or nonprofit after-school program focused on gun violence reduction in a school district.

- 2. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury the "School Safety Program 4 Fund", which shall consist of moneys appropriated to it by the general assembly under 5 this section. The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with 6 sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in the fund shall be used solely as provided in this section.
 - (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.
- (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund. 14
- 15 3. (1) If the general assembly appropriates to the school safety program fund 16 any of the following moneys or revenues, such moneys or revenues shall be provided for 17 school safety programs under this section:

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- 18 (a) Any moneys from the gaming proceeds for education fund;
- 19 **(b)** Any moneys received under the federal Victims of Crime Act of 1984, as 20 amended:
 - (c) Any revenues derived from any expansion of gaming in this state; or
- 22 (d) Any revenues derived from any imposition of use tax on any tangible 23 personal property sold for delivery into this state.
 - (2) No moneys shall be appropriated to the school safety program fund from the gaming proceeds for education fund before all amounts are transferred from the gaming proceeds for education fund as required under sections 160.534 and 164.303 and any other applicable state law.
 - 4. Upon appropriation, moneys in the school safety program fund shall be used to supplement, not supplant, nonlottery educational resources for school safety programs and shall be distributed to eligible school safety programs by the department of elementary and secondary education.

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
