AN ACT

To amend chapter 171, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to student athletes.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 171, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 171.055, to read as follows:

171.055. 1. Any student participating in activities at the Missouri state fair who is a member of an athletic team at a public school and who will miss team practices as a result of participating in activities at the Missouri state fair shall receive the opportunity to participate in practices relevant to his or her athletic activity at the Missouri state fair.

- 2. Any student who wishes to participate in practices at the Missouri state fair and who qualifies to receive this opportunity under subsection 1 of this section shall notify his or her public school team coach in writing at least ten days before his or her first day of attendance at the Missouri state fair.
- 3. Any public school team coach who receives notification from a student as described under subsection 2 of this section shall send the notification to a statewide athletic organization with a public school district as a member, and the organization shall provide a coach, approved under its by-laws, to oversee practices for the student.
- 4. The public school team coach of any student participating in practices at the Missouri state fair shall coordinate with the approved coach at the Missouri state fair with respect to the activities to be performed at the practices.
- 5. Practices at the Missouri state fair shall not be more strenuous for students than the team practices that the students could not attend as a result of their participation in fair activities.
