### AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the office of faithbased initiatives and religious liberty.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 37.660, to read as follows:

37.660. 1. There is hereby established within the office of administration the 2 "Office of Faith-Based Initiatives and Religious Liberty Advocate", for the purpose of 3 strengthening and expanding the role faith-based organizations play in providing social 4 services, making information about state grants and other state partnerships more 5 accessible, and promoting the fundamental human right to religious liberty.

6 2. The office shall be administered by the faith-based initiatives and religious 7 liberty advocate, who shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of 8 the senate. The faith-based initiatives and religious liberty advocate shall hold office for 9 a term of six years and shall continue to hold office until a successor has been duly 10 appointed. The advocate shall act independently of the office of administration in the 11 performance their duties. The office of administration shall provide administrative 12 support and staff as deemed necessary.
