## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to lobbying restrictions on members of the general assembly, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 105.1310, to read as follows:

105.1310. 1. No person holding any compensated position in any organization, whether for-profit or not-for-profit, which employs lobbyists registered with the commission shall hold the office of senator or representative. Any senator or representative who accepts compensated employment in such an organization shall be subject to immediate removal from office by impeachment subject to the rules, procedures, and practices of each chamber of the general assembly but shall not be subject to any other fine or penalty.

- 2. No senator or representative shall personally act or serve as a lobbyist, register as a lobbyist, or solicit clients to serve as a lobbyist during his or her term of office. Any individual who violates the provisions of this subsection shall be guilty of a class B misdemeanor. Any second or subsequent violation shall be a class D felony until December 31, 2016, and a class E felony beginning January 1, 2017.
- 3. Subsection 1 of this section shall not apply to senators or representatives who hold employment with any firm or organization that employs other individuals as registered lobbyists to serve primarily on behalf of the clients of the firm or organization.

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
