AN ACT

To repeal section 227.807, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the designation of a bridge.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 227.807, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
2 thereof, to be known as section 227.807, to read as follows:

227.807. The bridge on U.S. Highway 54 crossing the Missouri River at Jefferson
2 City in Cole and Callaway counties shall be designated the "~~Senator Roy Blunt~~ **Jefferson**
3 **City Bridge**". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs
4 designating such bridge, with the costs to be paid by private donations.
