AN ACT

To amend chapter 561, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the court disclosing certain consequences prior to accepting a guilty plea.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 561, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 561.029, to read as follows:

561.029. No defendant shall be permitted to plead guilty and no court shall accept a guilty plea from a defendant until the court has explained to the defendant the following:

- 3 (1) The maximum and minimum penalty provided by law for the offense that may 4 be imposed by the court;
- 5 (2) Any possible increased sentence by reason of the fact of a prior conviction or future conviction and any possibility of the imposition of consecutive sentences;
 - (3) Any registration requirement that accompanies the plea and the restrictions associated with the registration; and
- 9 (4) The consequences of the guilty plea on a defendant's ability to:
- 10 (a) Retain or obtain housing in the public or private market;
- 11 (b) Acquire loans for educational or other purposes;
- 12 (c) Enroll in certain degree programs;
 - (d) Retain or obtain employment;
- 14 (e) Retain or obtain an occupational or driver's license;
- 15 **(f)** Possess a firearm;
- 16 (g) Remain in the country; and
- 17 **(h) Retain or obtain custody of a child.**
