## AN ACT

To amend chapter 195, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to medical marijuana.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 195, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 195.835, to read as follows:

**195.835. 1. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:**

2 **(1) "Applicant", an applicant for a license;**

3 **(2) "License", a medical marijuana cultivation facility license, medical marijuana-**  
4 **infused products manufacturing facility license, or medical marijuana dispensary facility**  
5 **license, as described in Article XIV, Section 1 of the Constitution of Missouri;**

6 **(3) "Minimum standards", the minimum standards required to receive a license**  
7 **that are consistent with the provisions of Article XIV, Section 1 of the Constitution of**  
8 **Missouri.**

9 **2. Due to the demand for marijuana for medical use in this state and consistent with**  
10 **its obligation to lift or ease any limit on the number of licenses in order to meet such**  
11 **demand as described in Article XIV, Section 1, Subsection 3, Subdivision (1) of the**  
12 **Constitution of Missouri, the department of health and senior services shall issue a license**  
13 **to any applicant who meets minimum standards for the license for which the applicant**  
14 **applies.**

15 **3. Notwithstanding subsection 2 of this section, the department of health and senior**  
16 **services may deny a license to an applicant who meets minimum standards for the license**  
17 **for which the applicant applies in order to comply with the limits on the number of licenses**  
18 **issued to entities under substantially common control, ownership, or management**

21           4. The general assembly hereby abrogates any limits on the number of licenses  
22 established in regulations including, but not limited to, the limits established in 19 CSR 30-  
23 95.050(1)(A), 19 CSR 30-95.060(1)(A), 19 CSR 30-95.080(1)(A), and 19 CSR 30-  
24 95.080(1)(B).
