## **AN ACT**

To amend chapters 43, 57, and 67, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to demographics of individuals involved in law enforcement incidents.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 43, 57, and 67, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto three new sections, to be known as sections 43.245, 57.1000, and 67.2200, to read as follows:

- 43.245. 1. The state highway patrol shall submit annually, no later than March first, demographic information for any member of the patrol and individual involved in an incident in which force was used by either the member or individual for the previous calendar year. The information provided shall include, but not be limited to, the age, race, gender, height, and weight of the parties, as well as the type of force used and if there were injuries sustained by any party.
- 2. The information shall be maintained by the office of the attorney general and shall be made available on its website. The attorney general shall make internal policies regarding the dissemination of the demographic information via paper distribution and penalties for noncompliance with the provisions of this section.
- 57.1000. 1. The sheriff's office of any county in this state shall annually, no later than March first, provide demographic information for any sheriff, deputy sheriff, or officer and individual involved in an incident in which force was used by either the sheriff, deputy sheriff, officer, or individual for the previous calendar year. The information provided shall include, but not be limited to, the age, race, gender, height, and weight of the parties, as well as the type of force used and if there were injuries sustained by any party.

2. The information shall be maintained by the office of the attorney general and shall be made available on its website. The attorney general shall make internal policies regarding the dissemination of the demographic information via paper distribution and penalties for noncompliance with the provisions of this section.

67.2200. 1. The police department of any political subdivision of this state shall annually, no later than March first, provide demographic information for any officer and individual involved in an incident in which force was used by either the officer or individual for the previous calendar year. The information provided shall include, but not be limited to, the age, race, gender, height, and weight of the parties, as well as the type of force used and if there were injuries sustained by any party.

2. The information shall be maintained by the office of the attorney general and shall be made available on its website. The attorney general shall make internal policies regarding the dissemination of the demographic information via paper distribution and 10 penalties for noncompliance with the provisions of this section.
