## AN ACT

To amend chapter 44, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to restrictions on the free exercise of religion during an emergency.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 44, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 44.104, to read as follows:

44.104. 1. Notwithstanding section 1.302 to the contrary, the state, any state
agency, political subdivision, county commission, county health board, or any person shall
not prohibit or restrict the free exercise of religion, including attendance or participation
in any prayer, service, meeting, or similar religious activity, during an emergency.

5 2. During an emergency, any hospital licensed under chapter 197 shall not limit 6 visiting hours for clergy or persons ordained for religious or pastoral duties if requested 7 by the patient or the family of a critically ill patient, in accordance with such hospital's 8 established regular visitation hours and security protocols.
