AN ACT

To repeal section 569.170 as enacted by senate bill no. 491, ninety-seventh general assembly, second regular session and section 569.170 as enacted by senate bill no. 60, seventy-ninth general assembly, first regular session, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to burglary, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 569.170 as enacted by senate bill no. 491, ninety-seventh general

2 assembly, second regular session and section 569.170 as enacted by senate bill no. 60, seventy-

ninth general assembly, first regular session, are repealed and one new section enacted in lieu
thereof, to be known as section 569.170, to read as follows:

569.170. 1. A person commits the offense of burglary in the second degree when he or 2 she knowingly enters unlawfully or knowingly remains unlawfully in a building or inhabitable 3 structure [for the purpose of committing a crime therein].

2. The offense of burglary in the second degree is a class D felony.

569.170. 1. A person commits the crime of burglary in the second degree when he 2 knowingly enters unlawfully or knowingly remains unlawfully in a building or inhabitable

- 3 structure [for the purpose of committing a crime therein].
- 4 2. Burglary in the second degree is a class C felony.
