AN ACT

To repeal section 169.596, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to teacher and school employee retirement systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 169.596, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 169.596, to read as follows:

169.596. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, a retired certificated teacher receiving a retirement benefit from the retirement system established 2 pursuant to sections 169.010 to 169.141 may, without losing his or her retirement benefit, teach 3 full time for up to [two] four years for a school district covered by such retirement system; 4 provided that the school district has a shortage of certified teachers, as determined by the school 5 district, and provided that no such retired certificated teacher shall be employed as a 6 superintendent. The total number of such retired certificated teachers shall not exceed, at any 7 8 one time, the lesser of ten percent of the total teacher staff for that school district, or five 9 certificated teachers.

10 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter to the contrary, a person receiving a retirement benefit from the retirement system established pursuant to sections 169.600 to 11 12 169.715 may, without losing his or her retirement benefit, be employed full time for up to [two] 13 four years for a school district covered by such retirement system; provided that the school 14 district has a shortage of noncertificated employees, as determined by the school district. The total number of such retired noncertificated employees shall not exceed, at any one time, the 15 16 lesser of ten percent of the total noncertificated staff for that school district, or five employees. 17 3. The employer's contribution rate shall be paid by the hiring school district.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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4. In order to hire teachers and noncertificated employees pursuant to the provisions ofthis section, the school district shall:

20 (1) Show a good faith effort to fill positions with nonretired certificated teachers or 21 nonretired noncertificated employees;

22 (2) Post the vacancy for at least one month;

23 (3) Have not offered early retirement incentives for either of the previous two years;

24 (4) Solicit applications through the local newspaper, other media, or teacher education25 programs;

26 (5) Determine there is an insufficient number of eligible applicants for the advertised 27 position; and

28 (6) Declare a critical shortage of certificated teachers or noncertificated employees that29 is active for one year.

5. Any person hired pursuant to this section shall be included in the State Directory of
New Hires for purposes of income and eligibility verification pursuant to 42 U.S.C. Section
1320b-7.

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
