AN ACT

To repeal section 306.221, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to watercraft, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 306.221, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 306.221, to read as follows:

306.221. 1. No person shall operate or otherwise position a vessel or other object or any person in such manner as to obstruct or impede the normal flow of traffic on the waters of this state.

2. **No person shall anchor a vessel in a manner that positions the vessel within one hundred feet of a permitted boat dock on the waters of this state unless authorized by the boat dock permit holder.**

3. **No person shall secure a vessel to or enter upon a private permitted boat dock on the waters of this state unless authorized to do so by the boat dock permit holder. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply during inclement weather conditions or other emergencies, or actions taken to prevent an unsecured vessel from becoming a navigational hazard.**

4. Any person who violates ~~[subsection 1 of]~~ this section is guilty ~~[upon the first conviction of a class C misdemeanor and upon the second and any subsequent conviction of a class B misdemeanor]~~ **of an infraction.**
