## AN ACT

To amend chapter 161, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the establishment of a council for community education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 161, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 161.960, to read as follows:

161.960. 1. There is hereby established in the department of elementary and 2 secondary education a "Council for Community Education".

3 2. The council shall have a membership of eleven persons, appointed by the
4 governor. Membership may include, but not be limited to, representatives of the following
5 groups:

- 6 (1) Civic organizations;
- 7 (2) Community-based organizations;
- 8 (3) Community education organizations;
- 9 (4) Local government;
- 10 (5) Local school district administrators;
- 11 (6) Parent organizations;
- 12 (7) Post-secondary education;
- 13 (8) School boards; and
- 14 **(9)** Teachers.

15 **3.** The commissioner of education or the commissioner's designee shall convene the

16 first meeting of the council for the purpose of establishing the bylaws of the council and

17 electing officers to include a chairperson, vice chairperson, and secretary. The council

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18 shall not meet more than four times annually. Members may be reimbursed for expenses

19 but shall not receive a per diem allowance.

20 **4. The council shall:** 

(1) Conduct feasibility studies on the establishment of community education
 programs within the state;

(2) Advise the commissioner of education and the department of education on issues
 relating to the establishment of community education programs;

(3) Make recommendations for a state plan for community education which sets forth the goals and objectives of a community schools program and establishes a system of priorities for targeting available resources on the areas with the greatest need within a school district; and

29 (4) Make recommendations for the funding of local community education30 programs.

31 5. For purposes of this section, "community school", means a school that makes its 32 facilities available for citizen use, coordinates activities of local citizens in identifying 33 program needs and establishing priorities, identifies and utilizes available program 34 resources, and assists in the initiation of programs to improve the cultural, social, recreational, and educational opportunities available in a community. "Community 35 36 education program", means a program in which a public building, including a public 37 elementary or secondary school, is used as a community center operated by a school board in cooperation with other groups in the community, community organizations, and local 38 governmental agencies to provide educational, recreational, cultural, health care, and other 39 40 related community services in accordance with the needs, interests, and concerns of the 41 community.

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
