AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Mark Twain day.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 9.225, to read as follows:

3 **9.225. November thirtieth of each year is hereby designated as "Mark Twain Day".**
4 **The citizens of this state are encouraged to engage in appropriate events and activities to**
5 **commemorate the life and accomplishments of Mark Twain.**
