AN ACT

To repeal section 329.030, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to cosmetology.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 329.030, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 329.030, to read as follows:

329.030. It is unlawful for any person in this state to engage in the occupation of cosmetology or to operate an establishment or school of cosmetology, unless such person has first obtained a license as provided by this chapter; **except that nothing in sections 329.010 to 329.260 shall be construed as prohibiting any agent or employee of any medical facility licensed under chapter 197 or any convalescent, nursing, or boarding home licensed under chapter 198 from engaging in any acts of cosmetology as defined in section 329.010 so long as such acts are performed on the premises of such licensed facility, nor shall the premises made available for a cosmetology establishment for facilities licensed under chapters 197 and 198 be required to be licensed under this chapter.**
