## AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to minority stake interests in facilities permissible under Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 191.1125, to read as follows:

3 **191.1125. If an entity or entities outside the state of Missouri collectively own a**  
4 **minority stake in a marijuana cultivation facility, a medical marijuana dispensary facility,**  
5 **a medical marijuana-infused products manufacturing facility, an entity with a medical**  
6 **marijuana testing facility certification, or an entity with a transportation certification, as**  
7 **permissible under Article XIV of the Constitution of Missouri, such minority stake shall**  
8 **not exceed twenty-five percent of the total ownership share.**
