WHEREAS, an increasing number of radical activists and politicians have called for the abolition of the Unites States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE); and 3 4 WHEREAS, ICE was created in the wake of 9/11, which was perpetrated by numerous terrorists who were illegal aliens, for the purpose of enforcing our immigration laws and investigating criminal and terrorist activity of illegal aliens; and 7 8 WHEREAS, ICE has played a significant role in protecting American communities from illegal aliens responsible for drug trafficking, human trafficking, child trafficking, and countless 10 other crimes; 11 12 WHEREAS, ICE has identified or rescued 1,422 victims of sexual exploitation or human 13 trafficking as the result of the activity of illegal aliens; and 14 15 WHEREAS, ICE has arrested thousands of aliens who illegally crossed the borders and were responsible for dangerous criminal offenses ranging from drug offenses to assault to 17 homicides; and 18 19 WHEREAS, abolishing ICE would thus severely jeopardize the national security 20 interests of the United States and unnecessarily and recklessly expose American citizens to 21 needless suffering:
