5 6	WHEREAS, under the MIEP, Medicaid will only cover the care an inmate receives in an inpatient hospital or medical institution; and

8 9	WHEREAS, incarcerated individuals have been ineligible for Medicaid since the inception of the program in 1965; and

11 12 13	WHEREAS, national prison populations have risen exponentially over the past several decades, from approximately two hundred thousand incarcerated when Medicaid began to over one million in county jails and state prisons currently; and
15 16 17	WHEREAS, the MIEP places a tremendous financial burden on states, counties, and local communities as hundreds of millions of dollars are spent annually for health care services provided in jails and prisons; and

19 20	WHEREAS, the health issues of inmates vary, with many needing treatment for mental illness or other chronic diseases, including diabetes, hypertension, kidney failure, and cancer; and
