2	President from "time to time give to the Congress Information of the State of the Union"; and

4	WHEREAS, Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, Nancy Pelosi, has
5	refused to allow President Trump to give the State of the Union address in the chamber of the
6	House of Representatives as long as the federal government is shut down; and

8	WHEREAS, the state of Missouri supports the President in his endeavors to fulfill the
9	obligations of his office; and

11	WHEREAS, the President has visited Missouri many times throughout his campaign and
12	during his presidency; and

14	WHEREAS, Missouri is perfectly situated in the center of the country and would be a
15	perfect place for the President to address the nation:

17	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of
18	Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
19	concurring therein, hereby extend an invitation to President Donald Trump to deliver his State
20	of the Union address from the Missouri capitol; and

22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
23	Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the
24	President of the United States.
