1 **WHEREAS**, each year the Missouri General Assembly puts on display a composite
2 photo comprised of each member of the House of Representatives and the Senate; and

4 **WHEREAS**, each member of the House of Representatives represents approximately
5 37,000 Missouri residents and each member of the Senate represents approximately 174,000
6 Missouri residents; and

8 **WHEREAS**, every day both chambers review, debate, and vote on items that affect
9 future generations, including the state budget and legislation relating to schools, health care, job
10 creation, and many other important topics; and

12 **WHEREAS**, each member of the General Assembly ran for office for different reasons,
13 but all members want to make Missouri the best place for current and future generations:

15 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
16 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
17 concurring therein, hereby urge the General Assembly to place photos of children or
18 grandchildren of Representatives and Senators selected by a lottery system in the composite
19 photo each year to remind all members that their actions affect the lives of future generations;

23 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the
24 Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and each
