	WHEREAS, on February 7, 2019, Representative Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez introduced
2	a resolution in the United States House of Representatives indicating that the federal government
3	has a duty to create a Green New Deal to achieve net-zero greenhouse gas emissions in ten years
4	and
5	
6	WHEREAS, a document released by Representative Ocasio-Cortez's staff indicated that
7	they set a goal for net zero rather than zero emissions in ten years because they were not sure
8	"that we'll be able to fully get rid of farting cows and airplanes that fast"; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, eliminating or significantly reducing cattle and combustion engines would
11	damage the agricultural industry in Missouri, which leads the way in feeding the world, by
12	crippling the ability to engage in cattle ranching; cultivate the soil; produce and harvest rice
13	cotton, corn, soybeans, and other food products; and transport food products around the world
14	and

16	WHEREAS, making air travel unnecessary would result in thousands of Boeing
17	employees losing their jobs; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, the proposed Green New Deal indicates that the federal government should
20	ensure economic security for all people of the United States; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, a document released by Representative Ocasio-Cortez's staff indicated tha
23	the proposed Green New Deal sought "economic security for all who are unable or unwilling to
24	work"; and

26	WHEREAS, the funds required to pay for a guaranteed income for all may increase as
27	more people decide they are unwilling to work or are laid off as a result of the damage to various

30	WHEREAS, a document released by Representative Ocasio-Cortez's staff called for
31	phasing out nuclear energy; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, coal and nuclear power fuel the majority of Missouri's electricity
34	generation; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, the nuclear power plant in Callaway County provides highly efficient, low-
37	cost electricity for Ameren Missouri's 1.2 million customers; and

39	WHEREAS, the proposed Green New Deal would significantly damage Missouri's
40	electrical power industry:

42	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of
43	Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
44	concurring therein, hereby urge President Donald J. Trump and members of Missouri's
45	congressional delegation to oppose the resolution proposing a Green New Deal; and

47	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
48	Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for President
49	Donald J. Trump and each member of the Missouri congressional delegation.
