	WHEREAS, the state of Missouri has a diverse and dynamic weather system that
2	changes on a daily basis; and
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4	WHEREAS, residents of the state of Missouri are subjected to natural disasters and
5	emergencies at all times of the year, including tornadoes, floods, droughts, and ice storms; and
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7	WHEREAS, the state of Missouri needs to streamline response to emergency and natural
8	disaster situations so that Missouri residents receive timely and effective assistance when needed;
9	and
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11	WHEREAS, current Missouri law is not up-to-date with the emergency response
12	challenges currently facing the state; and
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14	WHEREAS, local emergency management teams deserve clear and concise guidelines
15	in order to most effectively complete their tasks should an emergency situation arise:
16 17	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Missouri House of
17	Representatives, Ninety-Ninth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate concurring
18 19	therein, hereby create the Task Force on Emergency Management Protocols; and
20	therein, hereby create the Task Porce on Emergency Management Protocols, and
20 21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the mission of the task force shall be to study the
22	state's emergency management laws and make recommendations for improvements; and
23	sure s'entergeney management auto and mane recommendations for improvements, and
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall consist of the following
25	members who shall be appointed no later than September 15, 2017:
26	(1) Three members appointed by the governor by and with the advice and consent of the
27	senate;
28	(2) Three members appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate;
29	(3) Three members appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; and
30	(4) The director of the department of public safety or his or her designee; and
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32	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall hold its first meeting no later
33	than October 1, 2017, and shall meet at least monthly thereafter; and
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35	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that administrative support and technical assistance
36	for the task force shall be provided by the department of public safety; and
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38	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force, its members, and any staff assigned
39	to the task force shall serve without compensation and shall not be reimbursed for their expenses;
40	and
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42	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall prepare a report containing its
43	findings and recommendations and shall deliver such report to the General Assembly no later
44	than January 1, 2018; and
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46	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is authorized to function during the
47	legislative interim of the first regular session of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, as
48	authorized by State v. Atterburry, 300 S.W.2d 806 (Mo. 1957); and
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50	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall terminate on January 1, 2018;

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53	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
54	Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for the
55	Governor and the Director of the Department of Public Safety.

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
