AN ACT

Relating to national American history and founders month.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

WHEREAS, we are approaching our nation's semiquincentennial anniversary; and

WHEREAS, America has long been a beacon of hope, individual
3 liberty, freedom, and the pursuit of happiness; and

WHEREAS, our nation depends on an active citizenry, well educated in civics and
5 history, to maintain our system of government; and

WHEREAS, our history consists of our nation's Founding Fathers, the men who wrote
9 the Constitution and the Declaration of Independence; and the free governments of the ancient
10 world, Athens and the Roman Republic, that informed their labor; and

WHEREAS, we are most desirous to avoid the fate of decline, decay, and dissolution
12 that laid low the glories of the ancients who first developed free institutions of government; and

WHEREAS, recent studies suggest that a sizeable number of Americans lack basic
14 literacy regarding the history of America and the structure of our Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the month of November seamlessly encompasses many important dates to
16 our national character, including Election Day, Veterans Day, and Thanksgiving; and

WHEREAS, the month of November is ideally situated to allow schools to continue to
18 develop ideas for the rest of the school calendar; and

24 **WHEREAS**, our nation's children are and will forever be the most important cohort of
25 society for the maintenance and propagation of our national institutions:

27 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
28 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate
29 concurring therein, hereby designate the month of November as "National American History and
30 Founders Month" in the state of Missouri.
