AN ACT

Relating to national American history and founders month.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

WHEREAS, we are approaching our nation's semiquincentennial anniversary; and

2 3 WHEREAS, America has long been a beacon of hope, individual liberty, freedom, and the pursuit of happiness; and 4 WHEREAS, our nation depends on an active citizenry, well educated in civics and 5 6 history, to maintain our system of government; and 8 WHEREAS, our history consists of our nation's Founding Fathers, the men who wrote the Constitution and the Declaration of Independence; and the free governments of the ancient 10 world, Athens and the Roman Republic, that informed their labor; and 11 12 WHEREAS, we are most desirous to avoid the fate of decline, decay, and dissolution that laid low the glories of the ancients who first developed free institutions of government; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, recent studies suggest that a sizeable number of Americans lack basic 16 literacy regarding the history of America and the structure of our Constitution; and 17 18 WHEREAS, the month of November seamlessly encompasses many important dates to 19 our national character, including Election Day, Veterans Day, and Thanksgiving; and 20 21 WHEREAS, the month of November is ideally situated to allow schools to continue to

develop ideas for the rest of the school calendar; and
