11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, under Article III, Section 20(b) of the Constitution of Missouri, the General Assembly may call a special session upon the filing of a petition with the Secretary of State stating the purpose for which the session is to be called and signed by three-fourths of the members of the Senate and three-fourths of the members of the House of Representatives; and

16 17	WHEREAS , the General Assembly should have prior notice of such special session in order to conduct research and draft legislation; and

19 20	WHEREAS , the General Assembly should agree to reconvene in a special session in September 2018, concurrent with the veto session, in order to explore this issue:

22 23 24 25 26	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby agree to file a joint proclamation calling for a special session of the General Assembly in September 2018 for the purpose of discussing the state's involvement in the institution of marriage; and
