## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment repealing Section 2 of Article I of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to the definition of person.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next

- 2 following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special election to be called by the
- 3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
- 4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article I of the Constitution of the state of
- 5 Missouri:

Section A. Section 2, Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is repealed and one new section adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as Section 2, to read as follows:

Section 2. That all constitutional government is intended to promote the general welfare

- 2 of the people; that all persons have a natural right to life, liberty, the pursuit of happiness and the
- 3 enjoyment of the gains of their own industry; that all persons are created equal and are entitled
- 4 to equal rights and opportunity under the law; that under this Constitution and the laws of this
- 5 state, unless defined otherwise, the term "person" shall mean only human persons and
- 6 legislatively-created or recognized judicial entities; that to give security to these things is the
- 7 principal office of government, and that when government does not confer this security, it fails
- 8 in its chief design.
