## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article XII of the Constitution of Missouri, by adopting one new section relating to initiative petitions.

---

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next  
2 following the first Monday in November, 2022, or at a special election to be called by the  
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for  
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article XII of the Constitution of the state  
5 of Missouri:

Section A. Article XII, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one new  
2 section, to be known as Section 7, to read as follows:

**Section 7. Initiative petitions placed on the ballot shall state the revenue or  
2 funding source, outside of general revenue, for any obligations proposed by such  
3 initiative petition. The Missouri general assembly shall only be required to allocate  
4 funds from the revenue source and in no event shall the funds stand as appropriated.**
