## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article XII of the Constitution of Missouri, by adopting one new section relating to initiative petitions.

---

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article XII of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article XII, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one new section, to be known as Section 7, to read as follows:

**Section 7. Initiative petitions placed on the ballot shall state the revenue or funding source, outside of general revenue, for any obligations proposed by the said initiative petition. The Missouri state legislature shall only be required to allocate funds from the revenue source and in no event shall the funds stand as appropriated.**
