JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to article I of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section relating to workforce opportunity improvement.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2016, or at a special election to be called by the

- 2 3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for

- adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article I of the Constitution of the state of 5 Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one new section, to be known as section 35, to read as follows: 2

Section 35. 1. Except in instances when this section conflicts with or is preempted by federal law, no person employed in the construction industry shall be required as a 2 3 condition or continuation of employment to:

(1) Become or refrain from becoming a member of a labor organization;

- 5 (2) Pay any dues, fees, assessments, or other similar charges, however denominated,
- of any kind or amount to a labor organization; or 6
- 7 (3) Pay to any charity or other third party any amount equivalent to, or on a prorata basis, any dues, fees, assessments, or other charges required of members of a labor 8
- 9 organization, in lieu of the payments listed under subdivision (2) of this subsection.
 - 2. Any agreement, understanding, or practice, written or oral, implied or expressed,
- 11 between any labor organization and employer in the construction industry that violates the
