### JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article I of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section relating to the recognition of daylight saving time.

---

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next  
2 following the first Monday in November, 2020, or at a special election to be called by the  
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for  
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article I of the Constitution of the state of  
5 Missouri:

Section A. Article I, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding one new section,  
2 to be known as Section 38, to read as follows:

**Section 38. All areas of this state shall be exempted from the daylight saving time  
2 provisions of 15 U.S.C. Section 260a. Beginning on the first Sunday in March of 2020, the  
3 state and its political subdivisions and agencies shall switch clocks to daylight saving for  
4 the last time and the use of daylight saving time for public purposes will be eliminated.  
5 After this time, daylight saving time will no longer be recognized as the official time of this  
6 state. This act shall become effective if and only if two states adjacent to Missouri pass a  
7 measure substantially similar in content to regulate daylight saving time.**
