23 24	Special note: Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner that preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall behave

25 respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and smoking are 26 prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall refrain from any 27 conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the microphone to speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is prohibited.
