# HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1816

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE CHRISTOFANELLI.

1           **WHEREAS**, the rule of law is a foundational principle of our Republic; and

3           **WHEREAS**, if a law is not applied to all citizens of the United States equally, it is no  
4 true law; and

6           **WHEREAS**, election authorities previously found no wrongdoing in former President  
7 Donald J. Trump's conduct during the 2016 election; and

9           **WHEREAS**, both the Clinton and Obama campaigns were found to have violated  
10 campaign finance laws and both merely paid fines and faced no threat of arrest; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the indictment of former President Donald J. Trump is clearly motivated  
13 by a partisan effort to hurt his future political efforts and further divide our country; and

15           **WHEREAS**, this political prosecution of former President Donald J. Trump as he  
16 runs for office will set a dangerous precedent for political civility and the rule of law:

18           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the House of  
19 Representatives, One Hundred Second General Assembly, First Regular Session, hereby  
20 condemn the political prosecution of former President Donald J. Trump; and

22           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
23 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for Alvin  
24 Bragg, the Manhattan District Attorney.
