

# House Resolution No. 324

1           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly deems it worthy to support and encourage any  
2 programs that exist to provide Missouri's senior citizens with an opportunity to utilize their  
3 experience and knowledge in a positive and meaningful way; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly also deems it worthy to support programs that are  
6 designed to provide participants with opportunities to develop better citizenship and leadership  
7 qualities; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the Silver Haired Legislature is a program that helps ensure senior citizens  
10 have a voice in state government while giving its participants a unique insight into the legislative  
11 process; and

13           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly has a long tradition of granting the use of its  
14 Chambers to such programs:

16           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri House  
17 of Representatives, One Hundred First General Assembly, hereby grant the participants of the  
18 Silver Haired Legislature permission to use the House Chamber for the purpose of their regular  
19 session on Thursday, October 21, 2021, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Friday, October 22,  
20 2021, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

22 *Special note:* Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner that  
23 preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall behave  
24 respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and smoking are

25 prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall refrain from any  
26 conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

28 Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the microphone to  
29 speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is prohibited.

31 Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains, or any  
32 surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including computers, phones,  
33 or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited.
