1 **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly has a tradition of granting the use of the House of
2 Representatives and Senate Chambers for mock legislative workshops conducted by civic
3 organizations; and

5 **WHEREAS**, TeenPact is a dynamic, hands-on leadership experience for Christian
6 students, with a mission to train youth to understand the political process, value their liberty,
7 defend their Christian faith, and engage the culture:

9 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that we, the members of the Missouri
10 House of Representatives, One Hundred First General Assembly, hereby grant TeenPact
11 permission to use the House Chamber on Friday, March 4, 2022, from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00
12 p.m. to conduct a mock legislative session;

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the sponsor of this House Resolution,
15 Representative Jered Taylor, or his designee, shall be present in the House Chamber and shall
16 assume responsibility for the group's actions for the duration of the aforementioned event; and

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the reservation of the House Chamber is
19 contingent upon chamber availability on the date and time requested in this Resolution and
20 that construction and maintenance projects are scheduled from June 1, 2022 to December 31,
21 2022.

23 *Special note:* Participants in the aforementioned event shall conduct themselves in a manner
24 that preserves the dignity and honor of the House of Representatives. Such persons shall
25 behave respectfully and dress appropriately for the occasion. Food items, drinks, and
26 smoking are prohibited on the floor of the House and lower gallery, and participants shall
27 refrain from any conduct that diminishes the decorum of the House Chamber.

28 Access to the dais is limited to the Speaker's podium for purposes of using the
29 microphone to speak to those assembled. Access to the staff area behind the rostrum is
30 prohibited.

31 Group photographs; the hanging of any banners or other items on the walls, curtains,
32 or any surface within the House Chamber; and the use of any equipment, including
33 computers, phones, or other items on the dais and rostrum area, are also prohibited.
