2	state relationship in 1980; and

4	WHEREAS, Missouri and Taiwan share the values of freedom, democracy, rule of law,
5	and respect for human rights; and

7	WHEREAS, Taiwan is Missouri's eleventh largest trading partner; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, the bonds of true friendship and a mutually beneficial trade partnership
10	between Missouri and Taiwan have resulted in strong economic, social, and cultural exchanges;
11	and

13	WHEREAS, a Taiwan Agricultural Trade Goodwill Mission visited Missouri in
14	September of 2017, signed letters of intent to purchase Missouri agricultural commodities, and
15	provided an opportunity for Missouri businesses to build a mutually beneficial trade relationship
16	with Taiwan; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, negotiations for a fair and reciprocal bilateral trade agreement between
19	Taiwan and the United States are an important step to further strengthen bilateral trade, which
20	would increase Missouri exports and promote investment in both countries; and

22	WHEREAS, Taiwan, as a responsible stakeholder in the international community, seeks
23	to meaningfully participate in the World Health Organization, International Civil Aviation
24	Organization, and International Criminal Police Organization:

26	NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that we, the members of the House of
27	Representatives, the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, hereby praise
28	Taiwan's mature and vital democracy; celebrate the thirty-seventh anniversary of sister-state

29 relations with Taiwan; and support Taiwan's appropriate participation in international30 organizations that benefit the health, safety, and well-being of its people; and
