9 10	WHEREAS, throughout this period of time, through no fault of their own, some federa workers have encountered difficulties in meeting their financial obligations; and
12 13 14	WHEREAS, some federal workers may have their credit rating adversely affected because of financial hardships from the lapse in discretionary appropriations by the federal government; and

16 17	WHEREAS, some federal workers may fall into debt as a result of not receiving their paychecks during the lapse in discretionary appropriations by the federal government; and

19 20	WHEREAS, there are federal workers in Missouri who are suffering financial hardship, through no fault of their own, as a result of the impasse taking place at the federal government
