## AN ACT

To repeal section 191.237, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to health information exchanges.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 191.237, RSMo, is repealed and three new sections

- 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 191,236, 191,237, and 191,238,
- 3 to read as follows:

191.236. As used in sections 191.236 to 191.238, the following

- 2 terms shall mean:
- 3 (1) "Fine" or "penalty", any civil or criminal penalty or fine, tax,
- salary or wage withholding, or surcharge established by law or by rule
- 5 promulgated by a state agency pursuant to chapter 536;
- 6 (2) "Health benefit plan", the same meaning as in section 7 376.1350;
- 8 (3) "Health care system", any public or private entity whose
- 9 function or purpose is the management of, processing of, or enrollment
- 10 of individuals for or payment for, in full or in part, health care services
- 11 or health care data or health care information for its participants;
- 12 (4) "Health care provider", the same meaning as in section 13 376.1350:
- 14 (5) "Health information organization", any organization that
- 15 oversees and governs the electronic exchange of individually
- 16 identifiable information among unaffiliated organizations according to
- 17 nationally recognized standards. Health information organization does
- 18 not include:

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- 19 (a) An organized health care arrangement, as defined under the 20 Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), as 21 amended, and its implementing regulations; or
- 22 (b) A research institution that oversees and governs the 23 electronic exchange of individually identifiable information among 24 unaffiliated organizations for research purposes only;
  - (6) "Hospital", the same meaning as in section 197.020;
  - (7) "Individual", the person who is the subject of the individually identifiable information, not including an inmate, as defined under HIPAA, as amended, and its implementing regulations;
- (8) "Individually identifiable information", any information that identifies an individual or with respect to which there is a reasonable basis to believe the information can be used to identify the individual, and includes, without limitation, information created or generated by health care providers, health benefit plans, organizations providing social services or assessing social determinants of health, and organizations that provide services to or on behalf of any of the foregoing;
- (9) "Participant", an individual or entity who accesses, uses, or discloses individually identifiable information through a health information exchange operated by a health information organization, and includes, without limitation, health care providers, health benefit plans, organizations providing social services or assessing social determinants of health, and organizations that provide services to or on behalf of any of the foregoing.
  - 191.237. 1. No law or rule promulgated by an agency of the state of Missouri may impose a fine or penalty against a health care provider, hospital, or health care system for failing to participate in any particular health information organization.
- 2. A health information organization shall not restrict the exchange of state agency data or standards-based clinical summaries for patients for federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) allowable uses. Charges for such service shall not exceed the cost of the actual technology connection or recurring maintenance thereof.
- 10 [3. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:
- 11 (1) "Fine or penalty", any civil or criminal penalty or fine, tax, salary or 12 wage withholding, or surcharge established by law or by rule promulgated by a

13 state agency pursuant to chapter 536;

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- 14 (2) "Health care system", any public or private entity whose function or 15 purpose is the management of, processing of, or enrollment of individuals for or 16 payment for, in full or in part, health care services or health care data or health 17 care information for its participants;
- 18 (3) "Health information organization", an organization that oversees and 19 governs the exchange of health-related information among organizations 20 according to nationally recognized standards.]
- 191.238. 1. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any participant may disclose, access, or use individually identifiable information through a health information exchange operated by a health information organization under this section and in accordance with applicable federal law, including the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), as amended, and its implementing regulations, without obtaining individual consent or authorization.
- 9 (2) Except as otherwise provided in state or federal law, an 10 individual shall have the right to opt out of having his or her 11 identifiable information accessible through a health information 12 exchange operated by a health information organization under this 13 section.
  - (3) A health information organization shall implement policies governing the privacy and security of individually identifiable information that is accessible through the health information exchange.
  - (4) All participants in a health information exchange operated by a health information organization under this section shall comply with all policies and procedures of the health information organization with respect to the health information exchange.
  - (5) To the extent any provision of state law regarding the confidentiality of any individually identifiable information conflicts with, is contrary to, or is more stringent than the provisions of this section, the provisions of this section shall control with respect to a participant's disclosure, access, or use of that individually identifiable information through a health information exchange operated by a health information organization under this section.
- 28 (6) This section shall not limit, change, or otherwise affect the 29 use or disclosure of individually identifiable information outside of a

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- 30 health information exchange operated by a health information 31 organization under this section.
- 2. (1) A health information organization shall maintain a written notice of privacy practices for the health information exchange that describes all of the following:
- 35 (a) The categories of individually identifiable information that 36 are accessible through the health information exchange;
- 37 (b) The categories of participants who have access to 38 individually identifiable information through the health information 39 exchange;
  - (c) The purposes for which access to individually identifiable information is provided through the health information exchange;
- (d) Except as otherwise provided in state or federal law, an individual's right to opt out of having his or her individually identifiable information accessible through the health information exchange; and
  - (e) An explanation as to how an individual may opt out of having his or her individually identifiable information accessible through the health information exchange.
  - (2) The notice of privacy practices may reference a publicly accessible website or websites that contain some or all of the information described in subdivision (1) of this subsection, such as a current list of participants and the permitted purposes for accessing individually identifiable information through the health information exchange.
- 55 (3) A health information organization shall post its current 56 notice of privacy practices on its website in a conspicuous manner.
  - 3. (1) A health information organization shall not be considered a health care provider and shall not be subject to liability for damages or costs of any nature, in law or in equity, arising out of chapter 538 and the common law of Missouri.
- 61 (2) Participants in a health information exchange operated by a 62 health information organization under this section shall not be liable 63 in any action for damages or costs of any nature, in law or equity, 64 which result solely from the participant's use or failure to use the 65 health information exchange or the participant's disclosure of 66 individually identifiable information through the health information

67 exchange in accordance with the requirements of this section.

- (3) No person shall be subject to antitrust or unfair competition liability based solely on participation in a health information exchange operated by a health information organization under this section.
- (4) All staff, officers, and members of the board of directors of a health information organization that operates a health information exchange under this section, whether temporary or permanent, shall not be subject to and shall be immune from any claim, suit, liability, damages, or any other recourse, civil or criminal, arising from any act or proceeding, decision, or determination undertaken, performed, or reached in good faith and without malice by any such member or members acting individually or jointly in carrying out the responsibilities, authority, duties, powers, and privileges of the offices conferred by law upon them under this section, or any other law, or policies and procedures of the health information exchange, good faith being presumed until proven otherwise, with malice required to be shown by a complainant.
- (5) Individually identifiable information accessible through a health information exchange operated by a health information organization under this section shall not be subject to discovery, subpoena, or other means of legal compulsion for the release of such individually identifiable information to any person or entity. Such a health information organization shall not be compelled by a request for production, subpoena, court order, or otherwise, to disclose individually identifiable health information.
