AN ACT

To amend chapter 71, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the limitation on the power to regulate a person's activities on sidewalks, streets, avenues, alleys, and other public places.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 71, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new
2 section, to be known as section 71.289, to read as follows:

**71.289. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
2 contrary, no city, town, or village shall pass any law, ordinance, or
3 resolution that restricts a person's freedom of speech or religion while
4 standing, walking, sitting, or ingressing and egressing on sidewalks,
5 streets, avenues, alleys, and other public places unless state law
6 provides for such a restriction.**
