SENATE BILLS NOS. 1067, 1308 & 1303

AN ACT

To amend chapters 226 and 227, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to designations marked by the department of transportation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 226 and 227, RSMo, are amended by adding thereto three new sections, to be known as sections 226.1170, 227.841, and 227.854, to read as follows:

226.1170. The department of transportation, in consultation with the Ozark Highland Distillers Guild, shall erect and maintain suitable markings and informational signs designating the Ozark Highlands Spirits Region in accordance with the map produced pursuant to subsection 4 of section 311.028. Signs shall be located along highways approaching or entering the region, with the costs to be paid by private donation.

227.841. The portion of U.S. Highway 50 from CRD Nowak Road continuing east to CRD Danz Road in Gasconade County shall be designated as "Police Chief Mason Griffith Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by the department.

227.854. The portion of U.S. Highway 63 from the south end of CRD 637 loop continuing north through the City of Freeburg to Dogwood Street in Osage County shall be designated the "POW/MIA SSG Paul Hasenbeck Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by the department of transportation.
