## AN ACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to electric vehicle charging station requirements.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto  
2 one new section, to be known as section 67.288, to read as  
3 follows:

**67.288. 1. For purposes of this section, the  
2 following terms mean:**

3 (1) "Electric vehicle", any vehicle that operates,  
4 either partially or exclusively, on electrical energy from  
5 the grid or an off-board source that is stored onboard for a  
6 motive purpose;

7 (2) "Electric vehicle charging station", a public or  
8 private parking space that is served by battery charging  
9 station equipment that has as its primary purpose the  
10 transfer of electric energy by conductive or inductive means  
11 to a battery or other energy storage device in an electric  
12 vehicle.

13 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any  
14 political subdivision that adopts an ordinance, resolution,  
15 regulation, code, or policy that requires installation of  
16 electric vehicle charging stations shall pay all costs  
17 associated with the installation, maintenance, and operation  
18 of the electric vehicle charging stations. No political

19 subdivision shall adopt any ordinance, resolution,  
20 regulation, code, or policy that requires more than five  
21 electric vehicle charging stations per parking lot, or  
22 infrastructure for future installation of more than five  
23 electric vehicle charging stations per parking lot. Such  
24 ordinances, resolutions, regulations, codes, or policies  
25 shall apply only to parking lots with more than thirty  
26 parking spaces designated for parking.

27 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
28 contrary, no political subdivision shall adopt any  
29 ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, or policy that  
30 requires any school or any religious organization, as  
31 described in section 210.201, to install an electric vehicle  
32 charging station.

33 4. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a business  
34 owner or property owner from paying for the installation,  
35 maintenance, or operation of an electric vehicle charging  
36 station.
