AN ACT

To amend chapter 105, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to reports by members of the general assembly to the Missouri ethics commission.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 105, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2 one new section, to be known as section 105.984, to read as
3 follows:

105.984. 1. As used in this section, the term
2 "employer" means any person, firm, corporation, association,
3 fiduciary of any kind, or other type of organization for
4 which an individual performs service, including any firm,
5 corporation, association, fiduciary of any kind, or other
6 type of organization owned by such individual.

7 2. Any member of the general assembly who sponsors or
8 co-sponsors legislation that will directly benefit their
9 employer shall disclose such information to the Missouri
10 ethics commission within fifteen days of introducing the
11 legislation.

12 3. The Missouri ethics commission shall develop a
13 mechanism for the reporting requirements of subsection 2 of
14 this section. The Missouri ethics commission may promulgate
15 rules to administer the provisions of this section. Any
16 rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in
17 section 536.010, that is created under the authority
18 delegated in this section shall become effective only if it

19 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of
20 chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
21 section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the
22 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter
23 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove
24 and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional,
25 then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed
26 or adopted after August 28, 2024, shall be invalid and void.
