## SENATE BILL NO. 129

## AN ACT

To repeal section 565.240, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the unlawful posting of certain information over the internet, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 565.240, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 565.240, to read as follows:

- 565.240. 1. A person commits the offense of unlawful posting of certain information over the internet if he or she knowingly posts the name, home address, Social Security number, [or] telephone number, or any other personally identifiable information of any person on the internet intending to cause great bodily harm or death, or threatening to cause great bodily harm or death to such person.
- 2. The offense of unlawful posting of certain information over the internet is a class C misdemeanor, unless the person knowingly posts the name, home address, Social Security number, telephone number, or any other personally identifiable information of any law enforcement officer, corrections officer, parole officer, or prosecuting attorney, or immediate family member of such officers, on the internet intending to cause great bodily harm or death, or threatening to cause great bodily harm or death is a class E felony.
