## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 301.125, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to an advisory committee on motor vehicle license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.125, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 301.125,
- 3 to read as follows:
  - 301.125. There is hereby established an advisory
- 2 committee for the department of revenue, which shall exist
- 3 solely to develop uniform designs and common colors for
- 4 motor vehicle license plates issued under this chapter and
- 5 to determine appropriate license plate parameters for all
- 6 license plates issued under this chapter. The advisory
- 7 committee shall adopt [a] more than one type of design and
- 8 color scheme for license plates issued under this chapter
- 9 [that commemorates the bicentennial of Missouri. The
- advisory committee may adopt more than one type of design
- and color scheme]; however, each license plate of a distinct
- 12 type shall be uniform in design and color scheme with all
- 13 other license plates of that distinct type. The
- 14 specifications for the fully reflective material used for
- 15 the plates, as required by section 301.130, shall be
- 16 determined by the committee. Such plates shall meet any
- 17 specific requirements prescribed in this chapter[, except
- 18 such plates shall be exempt from the requirements of

subsection 1 of section 301.130]. The advisory committee 19 20 shall consist of the director of revenue [or his or her 21 designee], the superintendent of the highway patrol, the 22 correctional enterprises administrator, [the director of the department of transportation, the executive director of the 23 24 State Historical Society of Missouri, ] and the respective 25 chairpersons of both the senate and house of representatives transportation committees. Notwithstanding provisions of 26 27 section 226.200 to the contrary, the general assembly may 28 appropriate state highways and transportation department funds for the requirements of section 301.130 and this 29 30 section. The committee shall meet, select a chairperson 31 from among its members, and develop uniform design and 32 license plate parameters for the motor vehicle license plates issued under this chapter not later than January 1, 33 34 [2017] 2025. Prior to determining the final design of the plates, the committee shall hold at least three public 35 meetings in different areas of the state to invite public 36 37 input on the final design. Members of the committee shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses 38 incurred in the performance of their duties under this 39 section from funds appropriated for such purpose. 40 41 committee shall direct the director of revenue [shall have 42 the] to implement its final design of the uniform motor vehicle license plates[, along with] and any specific 43 44 parameters for all license plates developed by the committee[, available for issuance in all license fee 45 offices in this state] not later than January 1, [2019] 46 The committee shall be dissolved upon completion of 47 its duties under this section. 48
