## AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the use of automated photo red light enforcement systems by local governments.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new  
2 section, to be known as section 304.286, to read as follows:

**304.286. No county, city, town, village, municipality, state agency,  
2 or other political subdivision of this state that is authorized to issue a  
3 notice of violation for a violation of a state or local traffic law or  
4 regulation, shall use or employ an automated photo red light  
5 enforcement system at any intersection within its jurisdiction. As used  
6 in this section, the term "automated photo red light enforcement  
7 system" shall mean a device, consisting of a camera or cameras and a  
8 vehicle sensor or sensors, installed to work in conjunction with a traffic  
9 control signal, which is used to produce recorded images of motor  
10 vehicles entering an intersection against a red signal indication.**
