AN ACT

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a reporting requirement for lost or stolen firearms.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 571.065, to read as follows:

571.065. 1. An owner of a firearm shall report the loss or theft of the firearm within seventy-two hours of discovering the loss or theft to the local law enforcement agency in the city, town, or village, or sheriff's office in the county, in which the loss or theft occurred. The local law enforcement agency or sheriff's office shall enter the make, model, and serial number of the firearm into the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System.

2. Failure to report the loss or theft of a firearm as required under this section is an infraction.

3. Evidence that a law enforcement officer has recovered a lost or stolen firearm that was not reported as required under this section may be considered as evidence that the last recorded owner of the firearm violated this section.
