## AN ACT

To repeal section 630.945, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to employees working in certain mental health facilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 630.945, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 630.945, to read as follows:

630.945. Beginning July 1, 2013, no state employee, regardless of job classification, who is working in a maximum or intermediate security mental health facility or any portion of a mental health facility which has maximum or intermediate security shall be mandated to work more than twelve hours in any twenty-four hour period unless the department of mental health declares an emergency workforce shortage. The provisions of this section shall not apply on the first Sunday of November each year when the standard time changes according to 15 U.S.C. Section 260a.
