AN ACT

To amend chapter 367, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the hold orders for personal property received by pawnbrokers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 367, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 367.035, to read as follows:

367.035. All tangible personal property sold or pledged to a

- 2 pawnbroker shall be subject to a hold order, as defined in section
- 3 367.044, for a minimum of fifteen days in which the pawnshop is open
- 4 to the public. This holding period shall be in addition to any
- 5 subsequent holding periods issued by law enforcement agencies.
