AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to liquor sales.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 311.199, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 311.199. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
- 2 contrary, a holder of a valid license to sell intoxicating
- 3 liquor in the manufacturer's original package to consumers
- 4 may sell such intoxicating liquor to a consumer in a
- 5 container other than the manufacturer's original package,
- 6 provided that:
- 7 (1) The intoxicating liquor is in a durable,
- 8 leakproof, and sealable container that contains one or more
- 9 standard bottles, pouches, or cans of malt liquor; fifty
- 10 milliliters or more of spirituous liquors; or one hundred
- 11 milliliters or more of wine. For purposes of this section,
- 12 a "standard bottle" is any bottle, pouch, or can containing
- 13 twelve ounces or less of malt liquor;
- 14 (2) The consumer orders and purchases a meal at the
- 15 same time that the consumer purchases the intoxicating
- 16 liquor;
- 17 (3) The holder of the license provides the consumer
- 18 with a dated receipt for the purchase of the intoxicating
- 19 liquor; and

- 20 (4) (a) The sealed alcohol container is placed in a 21 separate one-time-use, tamperproof, transparent bag that is 22 securely sealed; or
- 23 (b) The opening to the sealed alcohol container has 24 been separately sealed with tamperproof tape.
