## AN ACT

To repeal section 9.010, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the state holiday commemorating Lincoln's birthday.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 9.010, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted  
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 9.010, to read as follows:

9.010. The first day of January, the third Monday of January, [the twelfth  
2 day of February,] the third Monday in February, the eighth day of May, the last  
3 Monday in May, the fourth day of July, the first Monday in September, the second  
4 Monday in October, the eleventh day of November, the fourth Thursday in  
5 November, and the twenty-fifth of December, are declared and established public  
6 holidays; and when any of such holidays falls upon Sunday, the Monday next  
7 following shall be considered the holiday. There shall be no holiday for state  
8 employees on the fourth Monday of October.

**EXPLANATION**—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
