AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to liquor control licensing.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 311.087, to read as follows:

311.087. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter to $\mathbf{2}$ the contrary, any person who possesses the qualifications required by this chapter, and who meets the requirements of and complies with the 3 provisions of this chapter may apply for, and the supervisor of alcohol 4 and tobacco control may issue, a license to sell intoxicating liquor by 5 the drink at retail for consumption on the premises of any wine shop, 6 7 as defined in this section, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. on Sunday and midnight on Sunday. As used in this section, the term "wine shop" 8 means any establishment that uses dispensing accessories to serve wine 9 10 by the drink at retail for consumption on the premises where sold. In 11 addition to all other fees required by law, an applicant granted a special license under this section shall pay an additional fee of two 12hundred dollars a year payable at the time and in the same manner as 13its other license fees. 14
